Barry operates Spirit Of Place photography gallery in Gibsons, BC. A master printmaker, he prints and sells his work through his gallery and website, www.barryhaynes.com. He has been involved with photography since the age of fourteen. After a stint as a Navy photographer, he received a BA in computer science from UC-San Diego and spent the next ten years researching and developing software for Apple where, in 1987, he was slipped a pre-release copy of Adobe Photoshop from Russell Brown. Photography then prevailed and, since 1990, Barry has found himself authoring numerous books (his most popular being from his Photoshop Artistry series), doing digital imaging consulting and teaching his popular Photoshop workshops. He currently teaches workshops in his Gibsons, BC studio, but has also taught for Anderson Ranch in CO, the International Center of Photography in NYC, the Santa Fe workshop in NM and others.
